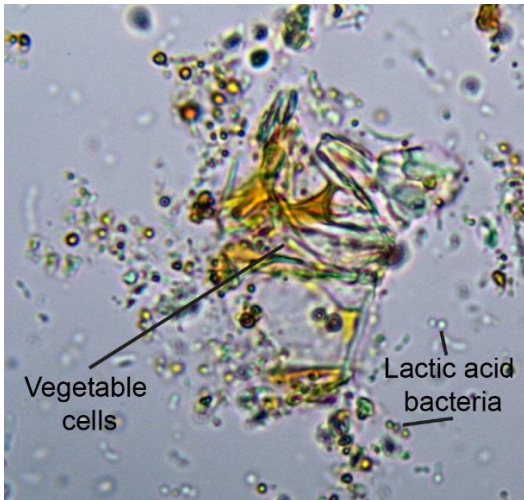
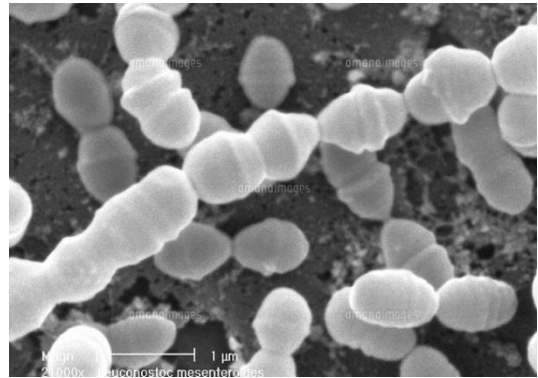


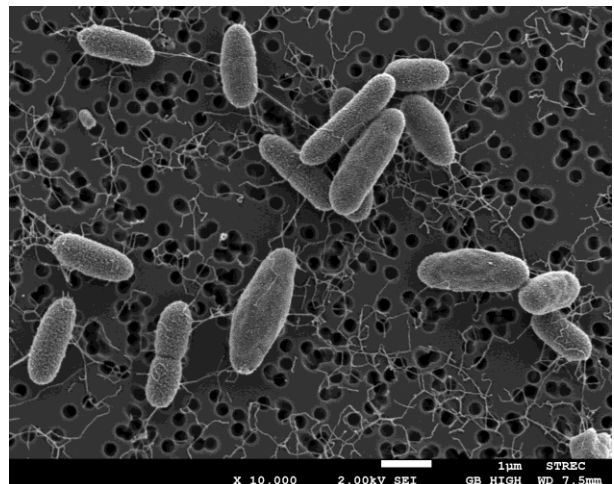
Lactobacillus: found in yogurt, cheese, fermented vegetables (like kimchi and sauerkraut)

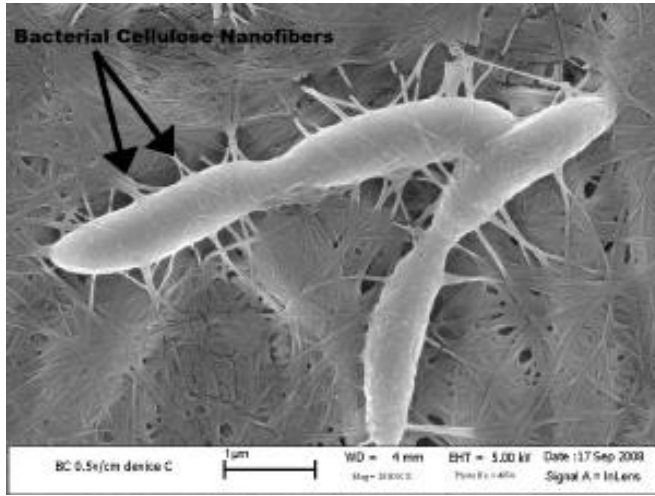
Leuconostoc: found in sauerkraut, kefir, kimchi



Kimchi under a microscope: Note the size difference between the large vegetable cells and small bacterial cells.

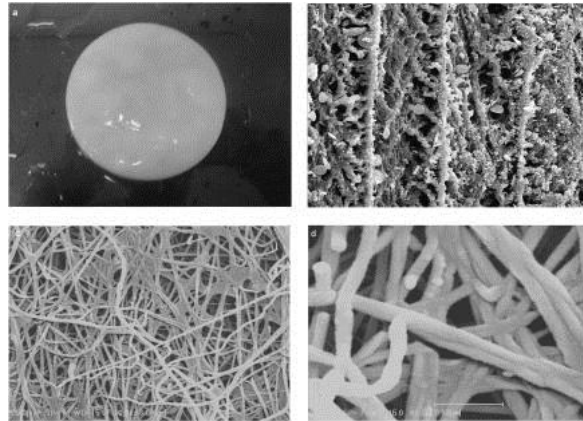
Bacillus piscicola: This bacterial species was first isolated from Thai fish sauce. Another *Bacillus* species, *B. vietnamensis*, was first isolated from Vietnamese fish sauce.
